Description

The Rembrandt Trio comes to LantarenVenster with a programme celebrating the life and musical legacy of Chick Corea. The Dutch trio has spent more than twenty years developing an adventurous sound built on refined interplay, curiosity and a willingness to keep exploring.

An important moment in the group's history came when it shared a double concert with the Chick Corea Trio during Ronnie Scott's International Piano Trio Festival in London. That meeting became a lasting source of inspiration and now forms the foundation of this tribute.

The programme features contemporary interpretations of selected Corea compositions alongside new music by pianist and composer Rembrandt Frerichs. These original pieces draw on Corea's rich musical language while retaining the trio's own distinctive character.

With double bassist Matheus Nikolaewski and drummer Vincent Planjer, Frerichs approaches the music with freedom, precision and close interaction. The result is a personal tribute rather than a straightforward reconstruction, celebrating Corea's influence while allowing the trio to follow its own path.
