Description

The Young Analogues bring the early music of The Beatles to Oude Luxor with Best of The Beatles '62-'65. The new generation of Beatles interpreters has been developed under the guidance of the original members of The Analogues, who ended their acclaimed ten-year run in late 2024.

Rather than relying on costumes or impersonation, the musicians focus on reproducing the sound of the records with close attention to instrumentation, arrangements and performance. Vintage equipment from The Analogues' collection helps capture the character of The Beatles' early studio years.

The programme follows the period represented by the Red Album, combining familiar number-one hits with increasingly adventurous material from the years leading up to Rubber Soul. It traces the rapid musical development that took The Beatles from concise pop songs to the richer studio work that would define the rest of their career.

The Oude Luxor Theater, originally opened in 1917, is a historic landmark in the heart of Rotterdam. With its classic theater ambiance, it has been a beloved venue for over a century, hosting legendary cabaret performances, stand-up comedy, plays, and intimate musical productions. Despite being severely damaged during World War II, the theater was restored and remains an essential part of Rotterdam's cultural scene. Seating around 900 guests, the Oude Luxor is cherished for its cozy, nostalgic atmosphere, attracting both established and up-and-coming artists.
