Description

Rotterdam Deathfest brings three American death metal bands to Baroeg, led by Ohio group Sanguisugabogg.

Formed in 2019, Sanguisugabogg first emerged with a primitive caveman death metal sound. Relentless touring and high-profile media attention helped push the band towards the top of the genre, but its music has also developed considerably across three albums.

The brutal foundations remain intact, including the distinctive snare sound, crushing riffs and guttural vocals. On recent album Hideous Aftermath, however, the group expands its songwriting with more detailed compositions and a broader approach to extreme metal.

Technical death metal band Revocation and New York slam death metal veterans Internal Bleeding complete the line-up.

Description

Baroeg is a legendary subcultural pop venue in Rotterdam, known as the city's home base for hard and alternative music. Since the early 1980s it has been the go-to spot for metal, punk, hardcore, rock, gothic, industrial, psychobilly and other underground styles. What started as an open youth centre grew into a full pop podium with a loyal community and its own annual festival, Baroeg Open Air.

The venue sits in the Lombardijen neighbourhood by the Spinozapark and has an intimate club vibe: a compact hall with a low stage, solid sound system and a bar where artists and visitors mingle. For many underground and alternative fans in Rotterdam, Baroeg is less a random venue and more a second living room.
