Description

Historic ship **De Oostenwind** becomes a musical instrument during Klankexpeditie Oostenwind, an audiovisual performance by Foundscape Orchestra in Rotterdam's historic harbours.

Sound artist Daniel Maalman and musicians Jasper Schütz and Jaap Mutter use self-built sound sculptures, mechanical devices and the metal structure of De Oostenwind itself to create a live, site-specific performance combining sound, light and maritime heritage. The performance lasts approximately 25 minutes.

The ship will be moored at **Wijnhaven on Friday 2 and Saturday 3 October**, before moving to **Oude Haven on Friday 9 and Saturday 10 October 2026**.

Tickets

Tickets cost **€5 for adults** and **€4 for children and VriendenLoterij participants**.

The performance is less suitable for children under 10 because of the sound levels. Due to the many small stairways aboard De Oostenwind, the performance is not accessible to visitors with limited mobility.

Description

De Oostenwind is a historic inland cargo vessel built in Belgium in 1962. The nearly 39-metre-long ship is a traditional 'spits', a type of narrow cargo barge once widely used on the waterways connecting the Netherlands, Belgium and France. Its working past and preserved industrial character make it a fitting piece of Rotterdam's maritime heritage.
