Italian shoegaze and dreampop band Glazyhaze bring their reverb-soaked intensity to V11 in Rotterdam, wrapping dreamy melodies in big, echoing guitars that can flip from soft-focus to full blast in a heartbeat. Their second album SONIC puts themes of love and self-discovery in the centre, playing with light and dark in a way that suits a live set described as both immersive and explosive.

This show also marks a new chapter for the band: the listing flags SONIC as a recent release and points to their first European headline tour, with a Music Moves Europe Award nomination adding extra momentum. If your playlist leans towards Slowdive, DIIV, Slow Crush or The Haunted Youth, this is very much in your lane. A suggested track is Forgive Me. The concert is organised by Rotown and V11, and is standing room only.
