## Description

Washington, D.C. quartet **BRNDA** head to **V11** in Rotterdam with a sound that refuses to play nice, or play it safe. Active since 2012, the band are described as exploring something elusive and uncompromising, with **no covers and no love songs**, just a jagged mix of art-punk, noisy no wave, and indie rock that can still lock into a groove when it wants to.

With four albums and an EP to their name, including the breakthrough record *Do You Like Salt?*, BRNDA sit comfortably in the lane of bands that turn tension into momentum. If **Parquet Courts**, **Talking Heads**, **Gustaf**, **Cola**, or **The Raincoats** are in your orbit, this should feel like the right kind of loud.

The concert is organised by Rotown and V11, and is standing room only.
