Description

Brighton six-piece **Flip Top Head** returns to **Rotterdam** for a show at **V11**, bringing along a sound that sits somewhere between indie folk, post-rock and orchestral pop. The band already made an impression in the city at **Left of the Dial** in 2024, and now comes back with the new EP Trilateral Machine in tow. Their music leans into layered arrangements, jazz-touched textures and ghostly harmonies, creating something that feels thoughtful, spacious and quietly unusual.

For listeners drawn to bands such as **Black Country**, **New Road**, **Man/Woman/Chainsaw** and **The Orchestra (For Now)**, this promises a set full of detail and atmosphere rather than blunt force. There is a chamber-like quality to the songwriting, but one that still carries the pull of indie rock. In the intimate setting of V11, that balance should land especially well.
