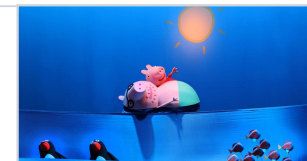


Peppa Pig live: samen op stap

The story takes audiences to the zoo, where the penguins need feeding, and to the beach, where giant sandcastles, colourful scarecrows and a lively beach party await. There will, of course, also be muddy puddles. Peppa would hardly accept anything less.

The show is built around singalong songs, dancing, colourful sets and plenty of piglet humour, making it a family outing for younger children and their grown-ups. Peppa Pig is known worldwide from the popular television series on Nickelodeon and Netflix.

The production is brought to the theatre by BazarMedia, the company behind family shows including De Grote Slijmmusical, De Zoete Zusjes Theatershow and Zin in Zappelin Live.

The Oude Luxor Theater, originally opened in 1917, is a historic landmark in the heart of Rotterdam.
