Description

London band test plan come to V11 with a fierce mix of noise rock, no wave, post-hardcore and dance punk. Since forming in 2022, the band has built a reputation for chaotic, high-pressure live shows, where raw guitars, sharp rhythms and restless energy collide.

After an earlier Rotterdam appearance during Left of the Dial, test plan now return for a headline show. Their sound sits somewhere between aggression and movement, pulling together heavy noise, punk urgency and a rhythm section built to keep the room on edge.

Fans of Fat Dog, No Age and A Place to Bury Strangers should feel very much at home here. The band also caught the attention of music critic Anthony Fantano, who included Walking in a Vacuum in his list of the 50 best songs of 2024.
